REUSABLE BAG DRIVE

On January 1, 2021 Guam Public Law 34-110 banning plastic bags across the island will take effect. Serve Guam Commission and AmeriCorps programs recognize that this ban may compound hardships already brought on by this pandemic for those who are economically disadvantaged.

How to Help:

- 1. Volunteer to help repurpose old shirts into reusable bags.**
Starting December 28th, SGC and AmeriCorps programs will be re-purposing old shirts to create reusable bags.
Limit 5 volunteers at a time from Monday—Friday.

- 2. Make your own reusable bags and bring them in.**

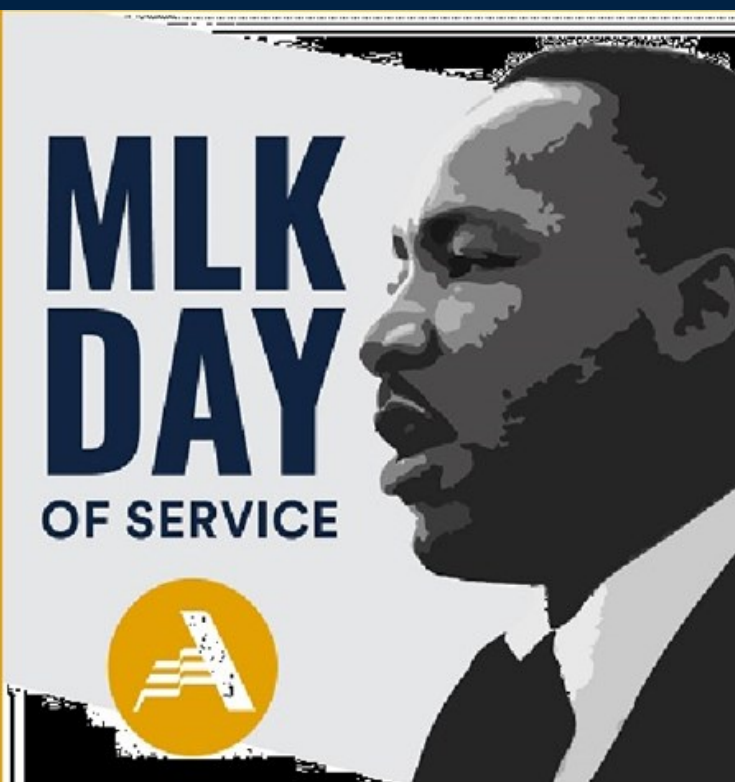
